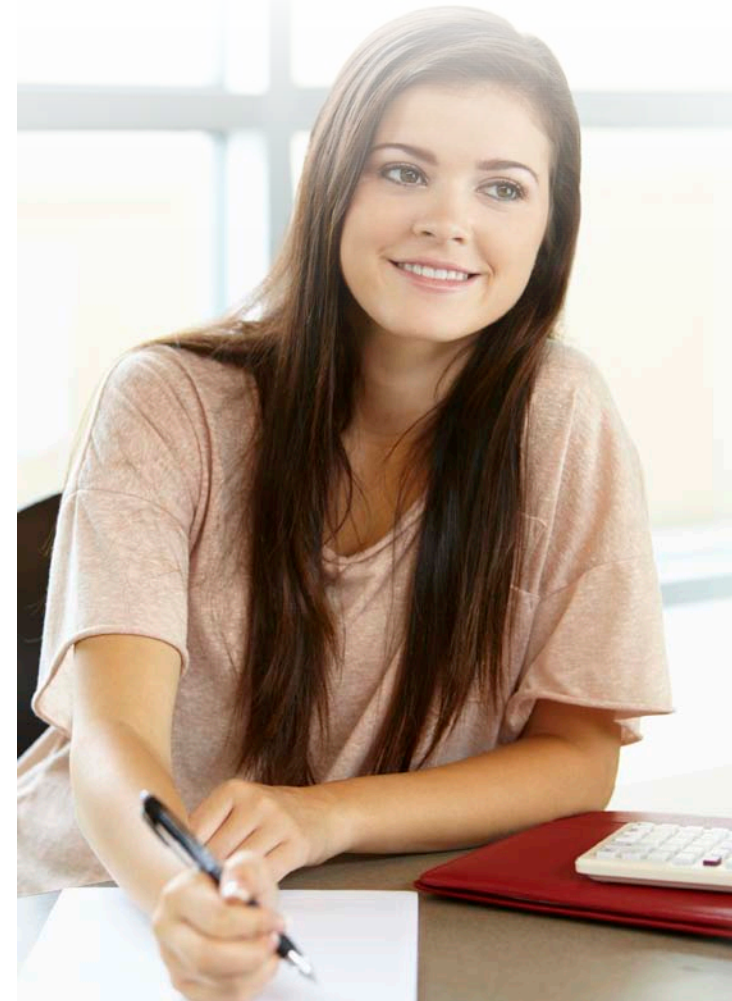

Can I take college courses and high school courses at the same time?

Dual enrollment programs are an opportunity for high school students to take college courses and high school courses at the same time. The college credits may count toward both your high school graduation and college.

Dual Enrollment Information

- ▶ High School Juniors and Seniors are eligible to enroll in the Water or Wastewater Operator Certificate Program.
- ▶ All courses are offered ONLINE.
- ▶ Lottery and tuition assistance are available to eligible students.

What are Youth Apprenticeships?

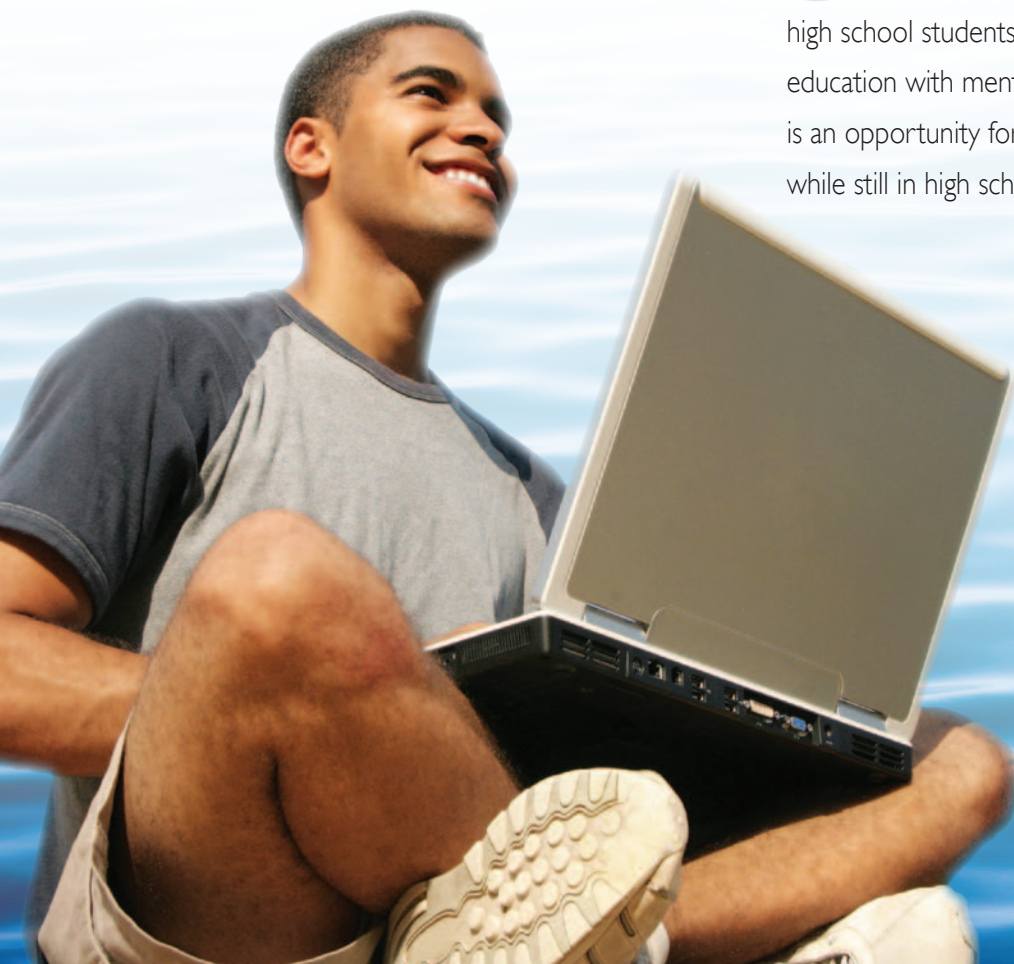
Youth Apprenticeships are rigorous programs for high school students that combine job related education with mentored on-the-job learning. It is an opportunity for you to experience a career while still in high school.

Youth Apprenticeship Information

- ▶ Enroll in CCTC's Operator Certificate dual enrollment program.
- ▶ Be registered as a Plant Operator Youth Apprentice with the Department of Labor.
- ▶ Work at a local utility for hands-on experience.
- ▶ Be paid for your work.
